



Buyer Terms and Conditions

- 1.** Remuda Classic LLC and its associates act as agents only on all sales and are not responsible for buyer/seller error or misunderstanding. All guarantees are strictly between the buyer and seller. All horses are sold "as is" without any other express or implied warranties and are not sold to stand a post purchase veterinary examination unless sold with x-rays and vet check.
- 2.** Any defects or bad habits must be called when the horse is sold. Optional vet on site for inspection at buyers request and expense. Sales relies on Consignor to validate horse is sound of limb and wind, is free of any vision abnormalities and discoloration in its eye(s); free of any hearing impairments, free of any overbite or underbite, is not a cribber or weaver, is free of any neurological disorder(s), is free of any mane and/or tail extensions and free of hoof damage.
- 3.** The consignor will have the privilege to no sale or passed out his horse or dog. If the horse or dog is passed out, the cost and fees listed in "Consignor Agreement".
- 4. Outside Sales:** NOTICE: ONLY HORSES/DOGS CONSIGNED TO THE SALE WILL BE ALLOWED ON THE SALE GROUNDS. ALL HORSES/DOGS SOLD, BEFORE, DURING, AFTER WILL BE SUBJECT TO THE EIGHT PERCENT (8%) SALES COMMISSION IN ADDITION TO THE CATALOG FEE IF APPLICABLE. ALL HORSES/DOGS MUST GO THROUGH THE SALE RING. ABSOLUTELY NO ALLEY TRADING. PRIVATE SALES: Absolutely no private sales with consignors prior to the Sale. Consignors have given Remuda Classic LLC Sale Exclusive Rights for selling the consigned Horse(s) and/or dog(s) Management feels this is unfair to the consignors and buyers who have traveled to attend the sale. All horse(s) and/or dog(s) brought to the sale must be consigned and go through our auction ring. The GUARANTEES only apply if the sale is run through the AUCTION. Be sure to call the office and let us know you have made arrangements to purchase one of the horse(s) and/or dog(s) that did not sell in the Ring to insure all sale GUARANTEES.
- 5. Marketing:** Data provided in this catalog is generally correct, but occasionally errors occur due to incorrect data received from others, processing mistakes and other causes. We disclaim liability for such errors, but appreciate their being called to our attention. Announcements from the block take precedence over printed material.
- 6. Title:** Title passes to buyer at fall of the hammer. All risk of injury to the horse(s) and/or dog(s) becomes buyer's risk at passing of title. Buyer agrees to release, defend, indemnify and hold owners, managers, and employees harmless from all losses, expenses, and claims related to the possession, care, custody, control or maintenance after the fall of the hammer of any horse(s) and/or dog(s) on which he or she is the successful bidder, whether resulting in whole or in part from their own negligence, including but not limited to any claims arising out of injuries or damage caused by the

horse(s) and/or dog(s) after the fall of the hammer. The horse(s) and/or dog(s) will be held for the buyer until buyer makes settlement as provided. Buyer shall immediately present himself to make settlement if requested by auctioneer, but in any case, shall present himself within thirty (30) minutes of conclusion of the sale. Buyer is responsible to check registration and additional paperwork at time of settlement.

7. Payment: Payment arrangements confirmed immediately following sale of horse(s) and/or dog(s) through office manager. Insurance, holding, and hauling options available. Terms and Conditions: Cash Accepted, Checks can be accepted, no Cashiers check. No acceptance on Checks. We accept all major credit cards, a 3% office processing fee will be added to all Credit Card. For ease and expedite of purchase by Buyers we recommend you register as a bidder prior to coming to the event. Please follow our online bidding link to register as a bidder.

8. Online/Absentee: There will be a 3% Buyers Premium charged for all Internet Bidding and 3% Buyers Premium charged for all Phone Absentee Bidding. Please register with HiBid prior to auction dates.

9. REQUIREMENTS FOR TRANSPORT: Coggins are REQUIRED for transport: All horses brought to the sale are required to provide a coggins test current within six months of sale date by Consignor.

Health Papers are REQUIRED for transport: Current Health Cert is provided by Consignor.

10. HORSE PICK UP: BUYER'S will be responsible for pickup of purchased horse(s) no later than Noon on Sunday following the sale. Arrangements to extend this deadline can be made by calling office. If extended stay is required for online/absentee bidders to make arrangements, we can assist you in securing off site boarding for a short term.

11. Auction Shipping Info: It is the responsibility of the buyer to make arrangements for transport of their horse(s) once it is purchased. Equine Transporters can be located on the Internet and we would suggest that you find someone that is insured and bonded. We do provide a list of some haulers but do not guarantee services. Again it is the buyers responsibility to review/validate transporters credentials. Shipping arrangements and expenses are solely the responsibility of the buyer. Sale management will make reasonable efforts to assist you.

12. Soundness Guarantee: There is no guarantee of any kind as to the soundness or condition or other quality of any horse or dog sold in this sale except in a case where the owner makes a specific guarantee. In such cases, the guarantee is strictly by the owner and not the sale management. The horse or dog must hit the ground sound on all 4 feet, be able to see and breathe. Any complaint must be filed with the seller within 5 days of sale.
